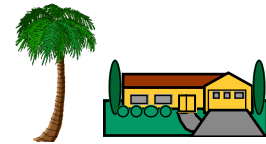

## Cypress Isles Mulch-a-Thon



Last September, after considering how much landscapers charge to install mulch, the board decided that Cypress Isles could buy its own mulch and neighborhood volunteers could deliver and spread it at the entrances in the spring.

On April 13th and 30th Cypress Isles board members and friends added a fresh layer of mulch (actually pine bark nuggets) to the front and rear entrances. The project used 159 bags of mulch that cost \$749, considerably less than the thousands of dollars spent by other similarly sized neighborhoods.

Thanks to Bob Conner, Christina & Sonny Dones, Cookie & Scott Symons, Frank Gallagher, Harold Engold, and Dennis Horazak for buying, hauling, and spreading all the mulch onto all the entrances. Cypress Isles will reimburse for the cost of the mulch. Photo creds to Cookie Symons, Mamarazzi!
